

Please note that in cases where kits are packed with a plastic tube separating components on the spindle bar (this tube should be discarded).

LEGEND

 $\overline{\text{ITEM 1}} = M6 \times 70 \text{mm}$ LONG COUNTERSUNK BOLT (x1).

ITEM 2 = BOBBIN (B0481) (x2).

ITEM 3 = MOUNTING BLOCK LEFT (M0482) (x1).

ITEM 4 = TAPERED NUT (H0062) (x2).

ITEM 5 = MOUNTING BLOCK EXPANDER (M0484) (x1).

ITEM 6 = MOUNTING BLOCK RIGHT (M0483) (x1).

ITEM 7 = M6 x 55mm LONG COUNTERSUNK BOLT (x1).

TOOLS REQUIRED

4mm Allen key.

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

Left-hand side (as you sit on bike)

- Fit the longer counter sunk bolt (item 1) through the crash protector so head sits in counter-sink.
- Place the bobbin on to the longer mounting block (item 3 M0482).
- Place the tapered nut (item 4 H0062) on exposed end of bolt so tapered face goes into recess of the mounting block.
- Tighten the bolt until the tapered portion of nut just contacts in the recessed face of the mounting block.
- Place this assembly into the left hand side of the rear wheel spindle.
- Tighten the bolt so the bobbin is held in position firmly (do not over tighten).

Right-hand side (as you sit on bike)

- Fit the shorter counter sunk bolt (item 7) through the crash protector so head sits in counter-sink.
- Place the remaining bobbin on to the smaller mounting block (item 9 M0483).
- Position the mounting block expander (item 5 M0484) over the exposed end of the bolt.
- Place the tapered nut (item 4 H0062) on exposed end of bolt so tapered face goes into recess of the mounting block.
- Tighten the bolt until the tapered portion of nut just contacts in the recessed face of the mounting block.
- Place this assembly into the right hand side of the rear wheel spindle.
- Tighten the bolt so the bobbin is held in position firmly (do not over tighten).
- Regularly check to ensure bobbins remain tight.



ARTICLE 5 = EXPANDER BLOC DE MONTAGE (M0484) (x1).

ARTICLE 6 = BLOC DE MONTAGE COTE DROIT (M0483) (x1).

ARTICLE $7 = M6 \times 55 \text{mm BOULON}$ (x1).

OUTILS REQUIS

• Clé Allen 4mm.

NOTICE DE MONTAGE

Coté gauche (lorsqu'on est assis sur la moto)

- Insérer le boulon (article 1) à travers la protection crash de façon à ce que la tête aille dans le contre alésage.
- Placer la bobine sur le bloc de montage le plus grand (article 3 M0482).
- Place l'écrou conique (article 4 H0062) sur l'extrémité du boulon de façon à ce que la face conique se place dans le creux du bloc de montage.
- Serrer le boulon jusqu'à ce que la face conique de l'écrou entre en contact avec la face creuse du bloc de montage.
- Placer cet ensemble du coté gauche du moyeu de la roue arrière.
- Serrer le boulon pour que la protection crash soit maintenue en position (ne pas trop bloquer).

Coté droit (lorsqu'on est assis sur la moto)

- Insérer le boulon (article 7) à travers la protection crash de façon à ce que la tête aille dans le contre alésage.
- Placer la bobine sur le bloc de montage le plus petit (article 9 M0483).
- Positionner l'expander du bloc de montage (article 5 M0484) sur l'extrémité du boulon.
- Place l'écrou conique (article 4 H0062) sur l'extrémité du boulon de façon à ce que la face conique se place dans le creux du bloc de montage.
- Serrer le boulon jusqu'à ce que la face conique de l'écrou entre en contact avec la face creuse du bloc de montage.
- Placer cet ensemble du coté droit du moyeu de la roue arrière.
- Serrer le boulon pour que la protection crash soit maintenue en position (ne pas trop bloquer).
- Vérifier le serrage régulièrement.

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
