Fitting Instructions for CP0074BL Crash Protectors Ducati 750SS pre '99

Please note that in cases where kits are packed with rubber washers holding the components onto the bolt – *the rubber washers should be thrown away*!

- Remove fairing panel and expose engine
- Undo engine bolt, located mid engine.
- Paint/tippex other end (head end), in order to make a mark on the inside of the fairing.
- Refit fairing panel
- Push engine bolt until it touches fairing (inside and makes a mark).
- Remove fairing.
- Pilot drill from inner to outer fairing.
- Refit and make sure hole lines up with centre of bolt.
- Remove fairing and drill 28 mm dia hole (tank cutter/cone cutter), working from outside towards the inside.
- Use sharp knife to deburr hole.
- Take R&G engine bar supplied and insert into original position. (Longer thread into engine)
- Refit fairing.
- Slide spacer over bar smaller end will sit into frame
- Fit bobbin. Tighten bolt until you feel some compression from inside the protector. Turn a little more so that you feel the compression increase slightly. Then apply a quarter turn. Do not overtighten as damage can occur to the bike. Do not exceed 40nm of torque.
- Repeat for other side.

Due to the risk of cross-threading of bolts etc; we always recommend that our products be fitted by one of our official dealers or a qualified mechanic.

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
